

## ECE News Update – March 2022

### **Current and Planned Activities Regarding the PK-3 ECE Specialist Credential**

Possible requirements for and pathways to a PK-3 ECE Specialist Credential were initially presented for information at the [September 2021](#) Commission meeting. A ECE Credentialing Workgroup was established to take a closer look at each of the possible requirements through focused discussions and breakout group sessions beginning in December of 2021. As a result of these intensive focused Workgroup discussions, the possible requirements, and pathways for the PK-3 ECE Specialist Credential were subsequently modified by the Workgroup. [Agenda item 3H](#) at the upcoming **April 7-8, 2022**, Commission meeting provides an update on the development of the PK-3 Early Childhood Education Specialist Credential that includes information on (a) the proposed PK-3 ECE Specialist Authorization Statement, (b) draft Teaching Performance Expectations (TPEs) specific to the proposed PK-3 ECE Specialist Credential, (c) proposed requirements for earning the PK-3 ECE Specialist Credential, and (d) PK-3 ECE Specialist Credential Preparation Program Standards.

The item summarizes the public input into this work that has occurred so far, including a public input survey regarding the ECE Specialist Credential TPEs and a series of focus groups regarding the pathways and requirements. A field review survey of the draft PK-3 ECE Specialist Program Standards will be conducted in April 2022 and a special ECE News Update will be sent with information about how to access and participate in the program standards field review survey.

The Commission is continuing its work under ECE Pilot 3 to develop, and pilot test the candidate performance tasks for a new ECE Teaching Performance Assessment. The assessment provides ECE teacher candidates opportunities to demonstrate their progress towards mastering the Teaching Performance Expectations (TPEs) for the Teacher level of the Child Development Permit. Programs that participate learn how to embed the assessment into their coursework and

practicum experiences, prepare their faculty and supervising teachers to support candidates as they engage in the process, and join a dynamic and energized ECE performance assessment learning community. ### **Update on ECE Design Teams Work Under the PDG-R Grant**

The ECE Teaching Performance Assessment Design Team held its ninth meeting on March 22, 2022. During this meeting, the Design Team had an overview of the Pilot Test process and reviewed the Draft Program Guide. The development work is currently being piloted through May 2022. This work is part of a two-year process of designing and piloting a new formative ECE Teaching Performance Assessment for candidates for the Teacher level of the Child Development Permit.

The ECE Program Quality Peer Review Design Team has developed a draft new Peer Review system designed specifically for ECE preparation programs. The draft system (Pilot 4) has opened up for larger participation with Pilot participating institutions having the option of participating in one of two cycles beginning with completion of the Self-Study by May 1, 2022 (cycle 1) and September 1, 2022 (cycle 2).

### **From the California Department of Education**

#### **Universal Pre-Kindergarten (UPK) Countywide Planning and Capacity Template**

The Universal Prekindergarten (UPK) Countywide Planning and Capacity Template supports County Offices of Education (COE) in the development of their UPK plans. The template includes: (1) Planning questions for COE consideration in developing plans for how they will support LEAs in their county to plan and implement UPK in a way that meet community and family needs, and (2) Data that will be required for COE submission to the CDE to meet the requirements of EC Section 8281.5.

#### **UPK Teacher Pipeline Resource Compendium**

The [Resource Compendium](#) provides summaries of the key investments and policy changes included in the 2021–22 State Budget that support the professional development and recruitment for the California State Preschool Program (CSPP), Transitional Kindergarten (TK), and Kindergarten workforce. These investments can be leveraged to serve the goal of building a highly qualified, culturally, and linguistically diverse early education workforce. Several of these

investments highlight the opportunities to use funds for activities specifically designed to support diversifying the workforce—for example, the Teacher Residency Grant Program and the California Classified School Employee Teacher Credentialing Program.
