

# PROGRAM SPONSOR ALERT

#### **SUBJECT: Program Modification Document**

#### Summary:

This alert provides details for the Program Modification document and what it needs to address. There are a number of program flexibilities that have been put in place by the Commission, other flexibilities were put in place by Executive Order N-66-20, and additional flexibilities were included in the 2020 Budget Trailer bill. <u>Appendix A</u> to this PSA identifies each of the flexibilities.

#### **Key Provisions:**

Each Commission-approved program must develop and maintain a document that describes the program modifications that have been put in place to address the COVID-19 Health and Safety Restrictions for the program. The 2019-20 (initial) program modifications document needs address the modifications put in place for spring/summer 2020. A second modifications document should be developed to identify any modifications put in place during the 2020-21 year.

The Program Modifications document should identify the full range of flexibilities that were implemented by the program and identify the percentage of the candidates who were afforded each flexibility. This could be done by identifying the total enrollment in the program and the number of candidates who used each flexibility. A sample form for the Program Modifications document is provided in <u>Appendix B</u>.

For programs that have a requirement to complete an Individual Development Plan (IDP) for each completer and for the completer to take the IDP to the Induction program, the IDP should identify which of the identified flexibilities were used with that specific candidate.

## **Important Dates:**

- July 31, 2020:Program Modification Document for the 2019-20 year should be completed<br/>and retained by each Commission-approved educator preparation program.
- Fall 2020:Begin the 2020-21 Program Modifications document. Record modifications<br/>as they are made during the year. Maintain the document at the program<br/>and update throughout the academic year.

#### Background:

A variety of flexibilities have been put in place for applicants, candidates, credential holders, and Commission-approved programs. <u>Appendix A</u> of this document provides a table that identifies each of the flexibilities, the authority that provides the flexibility, and when the flexibility is available.

For candidates completing programs in 2020-21, additional actions will need to be taken to provide similar flexibilities to these completers.
